The decision of the judges is final. Judging will take place in July, and the Awards will take place in September. All entries must have been received no later than 12 noon on Friday 30th of June in order to quality

for judging. One category only per entry. Gardens must be free to view to the public, apart from in categories 5, 7 and 8). Judging is usually by mystery visit, and you will be informed when your entry has been judged.
